

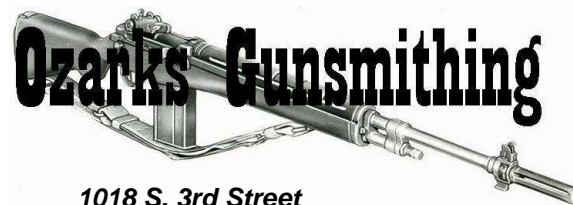
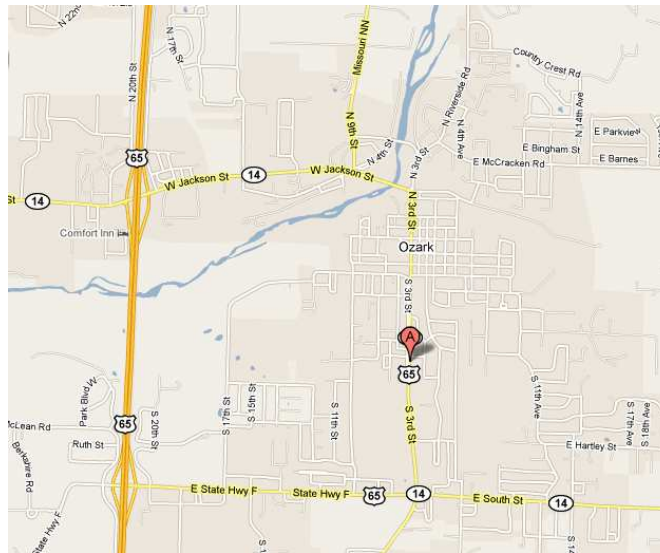

Firearm Definitions...



Long Distance (Over 600 Meters) Rural/Country Setting

— 308, 30-06, 338, 270, 50 BMG
8MM, 7MM

Large Game, Both Offensive and Defensive Fire Power. Bolt Action is preferred for dependability and shot placement accuracy. General modifications should include bedding, trigger adjustment, bi-pod, action accurizing, scope, and quality sling. Scope must be capable of sustaining set even through big bore discharge and terrain transport. Both drop well and detachable magazines are acceptable, however magazines support a quicker reload.

Avoid heavy oiling of the firearms. A very light film applied by the finger is sufficient. It is imperative that these firearms be thoroughly cleaned, moisture removed, and proper dry storage is essential.

General Failures for this type of firearm is extraction, magazine failure, shell ejection, firing pin failure, and bolt lock-up.

Proper ammunition is vital for accurate repeatable shots.

Medium Distance (250-500 Meters) Rural/Country Setting/Urban Setting

— 223/5.56, 243, 7.62 X 39. 30/30

Large Game, Medium Game, Defensive and Offensive Fire Power. Semi-Automatic is preferred for optimum ordinance delivery. Firearms are generally smaller in profile and weight for ease of use and transport. More ammo can be transported than a comparable long distance firearm.

General Modifications include trigger adjustment, action accurizing, plus peripheral accessories such as lasers, aiming systems, flashlights, rail mounting systems, butt stocks, grips, and special magazines.

Avoid heavy oiling of the firearms, except in the case of AK/SKS types. A very light film applied by the finger is sufficient. It is imperative that these firearms be thoroughly cleaned, moisture removed, and proper dry storage is essential.

General Failures for this type of firearm are extraction and feeding, magazine failure, shell ejection, firing pin failure, and proper gas dispersion.

Generally speaking, these types of firearms require a higher degree of maintenance such as cleaning, mild lubrication, and proper ammunition.



Short Distance (Point Blank-100 Meters)

Rural/Country Setting/Urban Setting
— Shotgun, 45ACP, 9MM, 38 SPL, 357, 380, 32, 25ACP, 22

Small Game, Medium Game, Defensive and Offensive Fire Power. However, hunting with hand guns requires a high degree of skill and practice. The best, most reliable short range firearm is a shotgun, preferably a pump action.



Following the shotgun is the revolver and semi-automatic pistol. Each of these firearms have unique attributes that make them ideal for varying situations such as the hand guns ability to conceal and deliver a respectable amount of ordinance. Their size affords easier carry, aiming, and generally faster reload. The firearms can be modified and re-worked to fit just about any need including trigger adjustments, action accurizing, special sites and lasers, grips and stocks, and other accessories. Priorities in the groups are affected by age, physical condition, and environment.

You should have a minimum of one firearm from each of these families and they all need to be in top working order and safe function.
